Other widows also say, "Thank you."



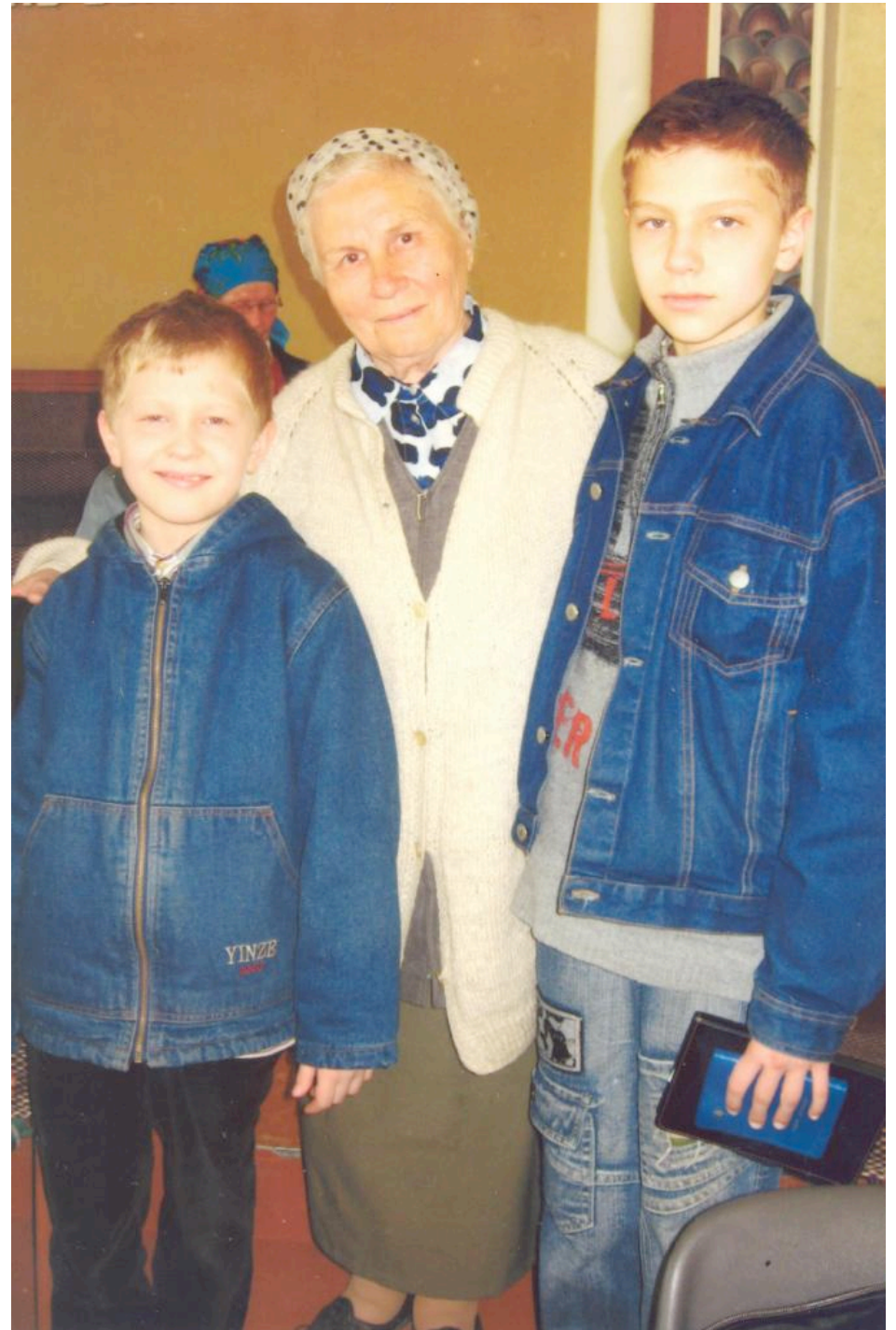






Widows from Tajikistan offer gratitude to God.

Irina has a four-year-old son. She lives with her mother and sister who will not allow Irina to take her son to church.

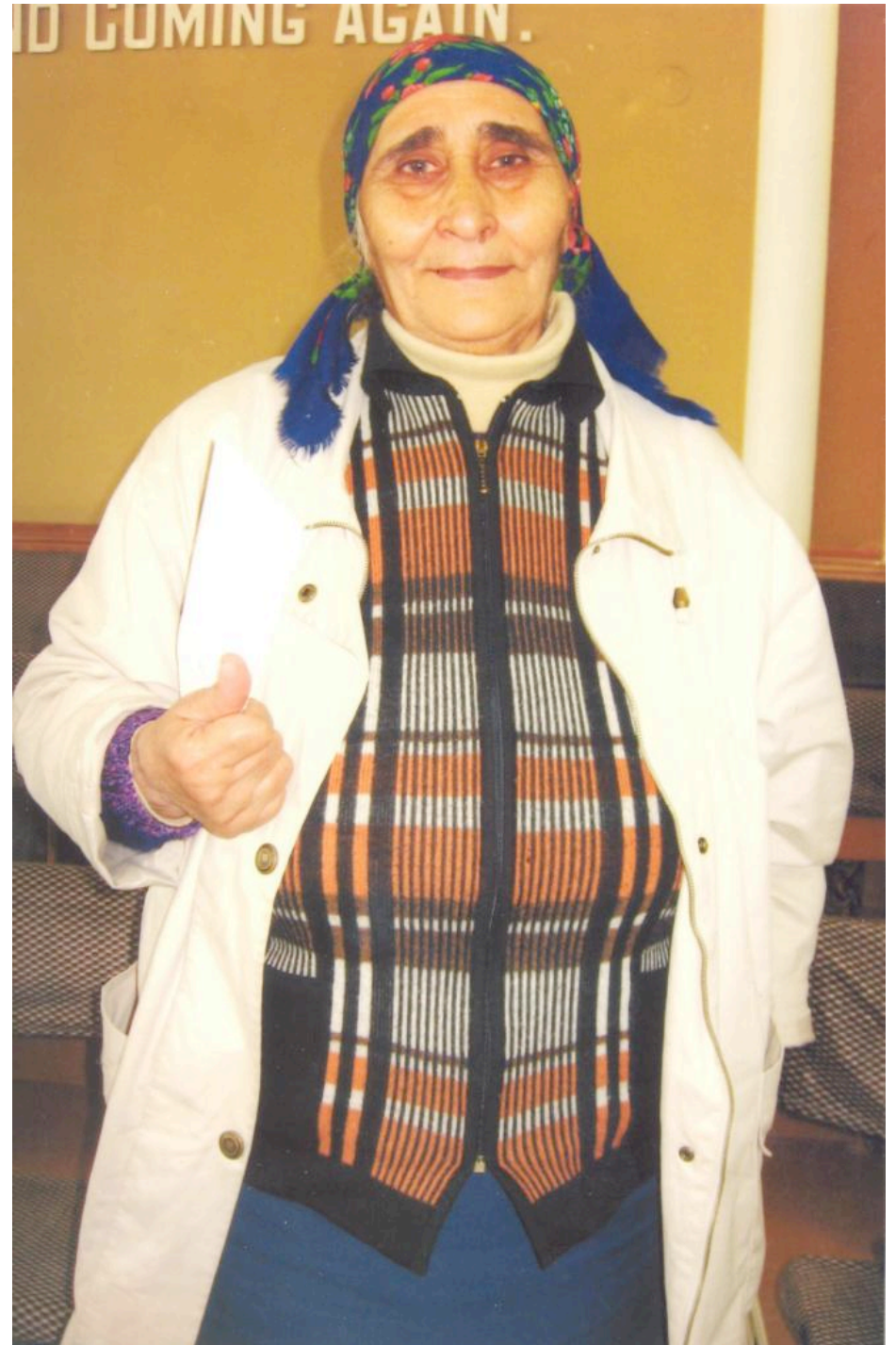


Anna, who claims many grandchildren, says:

Albina, a breast cancer survivor who is now raising her grandson, receives help through this gift.



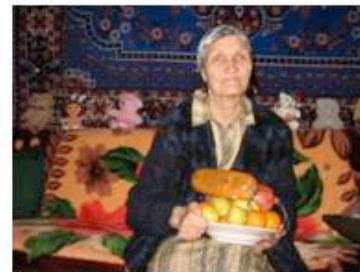
Svetlana and her son Gena give thanks to God for this unexpected gift.
